Title: Facility Operator

Entity: Spectra Venue Management

Status: Part Time or Full Time

Reports To: Facility Operator Supervisor

Summary:

Under the supervision of the Facility Operator Supervisor, the Facility Operator's primary responsibilities include ice resurfacing, edging, ice plant readings and compressor readings. Facility Operators will look after general building cleanliness, and are responsible for various maintenance jobs as assigned. They will ensure floods are done on time while following safe operating procedures.

Job Functions:

- Ice surface maintenance including install and removal of ice, floods, scrapes, edging, ice taps and zamboni checks
- Janitorial duties such as cleaning dressing rooms, players benches, penalty boxes, washrooms and other public areas
- Complete and record plant readings
- Update and maintain log book records
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Ice Facility Operator (IFO) Certificate (minimum level required), BC 5th Class Power Engineering Certificate or a Refrigerator Operator Certificate (will consider out of province certification and Refrigeration Safety Awareness Certificate (RSA) with appropriate experience)
- Previous experience operating ice resurfacing equipment
- High School Diploma or Equivalent. Post-secondary level education an added asset
- Willing to work different shifts including nights, weekends and holidays
- Good communication skills both written and verbal
- Possession of, or ability to obtain a current CPR certificate
- Possession of, or ability to obtain a driver's license
- Working knowledge of the proper use and maintenance of hand and power tools related to job functions
- Knowledge of customer service practices
- Basic computer skills

Physical Demands:

- Ability to respectively kneel, crouch, reach, maneuvering stairs and lift heavy objects
- Ability to work from an elevated position
- Ability to multi-task and prioritize tasks in a fast paced environment
- Ability to problem solve and think critically
- Ability to work independently or with a team
